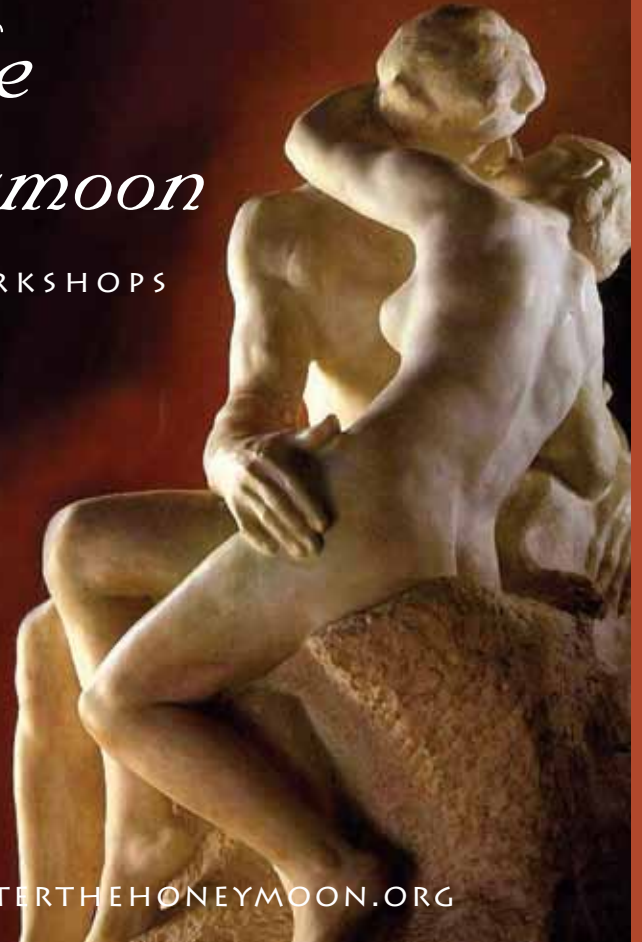

## FALL IN LOVE WEEKEND RETREAT

During this two-day workshop we will practice the essential ingredients for creating and maintaining a mutually satisfying erotic life. You will learn effective communication, combining emotional connection with erotic exploration. Practical tools, which form the basis for relational transformation, are provided. Couples are guided into remembering the depth of their love.

We use discussion and experiential exercises to explore such topics as:

- the importance of erotic connection in a committed relationship
- identifying and expressing what you want
- self-empowerment through self-responsibility
- creating the space for love
- approaching sensitive topics in effective ways

Couples are guided into increasingly intimate private conversations, then prompted to do an erotic “homework” assignment that becomes the basis for a transformational practice.

While romantic, this weekend is also practical. Couples will leave the weekend with a concrete and unique plan for deepening their erotic connection over time. It is also an ideal adjunct to couples therapy.

“Erotic partnership” — a committed relationship of deep friendship, clear collaboration, romance and mutually satisfying sexuality.
